### **POINT SCORE RUNNING SHEET**

- Arrive at 7am to sign on for point score. We are limited by time, once heats fill up in your division you will not be able to surf. First in, first served.
- Heats will be drawn randomly in each division
- Surf/weather conditions will have a bearing on the order in which each division will surf.
- A maximum of 2 surfers will be allowed to act as water patrol whilst heats are underway. Water patrol surfers are to stay well out of the way of competing surfers. The primary focus of water patrol is the welfare of competing surfers (particularly young surfers), and to ensure that non-competitors do not drift into the competition area.

### **EXPECTATIONS OF MEMBERS**

- As a member of Sandon Point Boardriders (SPB), you are expected to make yourself available for team events if selected.
- Help with setting up tents and equipment, stick around and help with judging after your heat. Don't just surf and go home.
- Help with pack up at the end of the day, many hands make light work.
- Attend the end of season presentation and support any other fund-raising/community event held by SPB where available.
- Keep the positive image of the club in mind. SPB reserves the right to suspend or cancel the membership of any person, who in the view of the committee has brought the club into disrepute.
